Issues with the programming including missing calculations, test screens, wrong link, bad equation Deviation from the specification Software bugs that could not be corrected high maintenance of the program obsolete programming language Iack of application development documentation funding issues for more maintenance and development To reduce the impact on construction activities, the Department developed and tested AcPayIII in-house. The Engineer will issue a no-cost CCO to allow the contractor to use AcPayIII (posted on-line for download) in lieu of PACRS. HMAPay is currently under development by METS which will be used with the new section 39.
