Subject: Day After Thanksgiving-Nonworking Day

The day after Thanksgiving has traditionally been charged as a working day. In accordance with a recent amendment to the 2006 *Standard Specifications*, the day after Thanksgiving is now a nonworking day.

For ongoing contracts that do not have the amendment to the 2006 *Standard Specifications* mentioned above, resident engineers may consider the day after Thanksgiving a nonworking day on the weekly statement of working days with an approved contract change order. This construction procedure directive (CPD) serves as blanket approval of these contract change orders.

The five-day and seven-day construction calendars have been updated to indicate the day is a nonworking day. In addition, the day numbering following this day has been revised to reflect this change.

A copy of the updated 2008 five-day construction calendar is attached. The updated five-day and seven-day construction calendars for 2008 through 2020 are posted on the Division of Construction internet website.
