The contractor requested use of dust palliative for construction dust control.

Reason for Change

Governor Brown issued a State of Emergency declaration on January 17, 2014 because of the current drought in California. The emergency declaration includes the provision that state agencies, led by the Department of General Services, will immediately implement water use reduction plans for all state facilities. These plans will include immediate water conservation actions.

The Department of Public Health has declared "severe water shortage areas," including portions of Fresno, Madera, Mariposa, Kern, Amador, Mendocino, Nevada, Placer, and Santa Cruz counties, and the cities of Healdsburg and Cloverdale in Sonoma County.

The use of potable water is a waste or unreasonable use of domestic water for construction activities under current drought conditions and dust palliative should be used to conserve domestic water to avoid future shortages. To reduce the use of water the state will share in the costs of using dust palliatives for dust control instead of using water.

Concurrence

This change order is in accordance with Division of Construction CPD 14-1, dated March 4, 2014. FHWA gave blanket approval for this change on February 12, 2014.

Method of Payment*Use for Agreed Price*

Agreed lump sum price of \$ _____. The agreed lump sum price is based on a force account analysis filed in the project records, and represents state sharing 50-50 with the contractor the difference between the costs as planned to use water versus the cost to use dust palliative for dust control.

Use for Extra Work

Extra work at force account based on the state sharing 50-50 with the contractor the difference between the costs as planned to use water versus the cost to use dust palliative for dust control.

Time Adjustment

No time adjustment due to this change order for using dust palliative.
