Subject: PROTECTION FROM EXPOSURE TO RESPIRABLE CRYSTALLINE SILICA TRAINING

This directive announces new training for construction field staff to avoid overexposure (exposure above the action level or permissible level) to respirable crystalline silica on projects within the state right-of-way. This training provides information about health issues related to silica, the construction operations that expose employees to silica, and the methods to prevent overexposure.

The U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration lowered the permissible exposure level and introduced a new action level. Enforcement of the standard is to begin September 23, 2017. To comply with the U.S. standard, the California Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Occupational Safety & Health adopted the changes, effective the same date.
